Application Form

Eligibility

The Y'DIYAH Memorial Fund will support quality non-doctrinaire materials and projects that serve to educate about the heritage, history, customs and culture of traditional Judaism through music, arts, literature, theater, etc. Preference will be given to material and programs that most closely fulfill the goals of the Fund and reach out to the broadest community.

Individuals, educational institutions, cultural and entertainment venues, community centers, libraries and other not-for-profit organizations, principally in Berkshire, Columbia, NW Litchfield, and NE Dutchess Counties, may apply. The Fund would like to reach out in particular to those of high school age or older.

Please note that requests for retroactive funding will not be considered.

Previous grants have been awarded for :

The purchase of books, videos and CD's in schools and public libraries; a multi-media presentation of Klezmer; an illustrated lecture by a popular cartoonist on the historic use of current printing techniques in the Jewish media; high school and college student concerts; student research, journals and writings on pertinent subject material; a synagogue-based interfaith program; a field trip to a Jewish educational facility by an interfaith group; a school project to interview, compile and publish history on the town's Jewish residents, staged reading, theatrical performances and other excellent projects. All requests that fulfill the Fund's goals, limited only by ingenuity and imagination, will be fully considered.

The Committee of The Y'DIYAH Memorial Fund has compiled a limited list of resource material and will attempt to keep it current for the convenience of applicants. It is by no means determinant but endeavors to suggest ideas that encompass the criteria of the Fund. Please contact Berkshire Taconic if you would like to have a copy sent to you.

Berkshire Taconic Community Foundation does not support organizations which in their constitution, by-laws, or practice, discriminate against a person or group on the basis of age, race, national origin, ethnicity, gender, disability, sexual orientation, political affiliation or religious belief.

Awards

Grants up to \$500 will be awarded twice a year. At the discretion of the Y'DIYAH Memorial Fund Committee, occasionally a grant of up to \$1,000 may be awarded.

Deadline and Notification

Grants will be reviewed twice a year. Completed applications must be received at Berkshire Taconic's office by either November 1 or April 1.

Applicants will be informed of the Foundation's decision within six weeks of the deadline dates.

Review Process

Applications will be reviewed by the Y'Diyah Advisory Committee. Their recommendations will be reviewed by Berkshire Taconic's board of directors.

Review Criteria

Created in memory of the founder's maternal family, in order to:

- Facilitate knowledge and understanding of the history, culture and practice of traditional Judaism, with the broadest-based community in mind.
- Correct misconceptions and bias
- Encourage learning
- Encourage tolerance
